

COVID19 Excluded Entry Policy

Club Taree Policies

Scope & Breach

This policy applies to all club members, members' guests, temporary members, and other customers of the club and all the activities of Club Taree.

Any breach of this policy may be referred to the Police or the Disciplinary Committee.

Members who abuse or disrespect staff, management, directors, contractors or representatives of Club Taree may be referred to the Disciplinary Panel.

Members and Guests are reminded of their obligations under Club Taree's Bullying and Harassment Policy.

Members are reminded of their obligations under Club Taree By-Laws.

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Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to provide the Chief Executive Officer with a clear filter for the exclusion of Members, Guests and Staff during the COVID19 pandemic.

The intent of the policy is to create a fair, manageable and clear filter for the exclusion of a person or persons.

This exclusion is to assist with maintaining the health and safety of Club Taree employees, contractors, members and guests.

It is also in place to minimise the risk of public fear, panic as well as physical or psychological discomfort.

The policy seeks to minimise the risk of Club Taree becoming a COVID19 exposure site.

The policy seeks to protect employees from being placed into situations of possible confrontation from other parties, or needing to react to situations of public questioning.

Club Taree acknowledges that during a pandemic public scrutiny and fear may be increased.

Procedures and standards are created and followed to ensure the safety, comfort and wellbeing of all persons on the premises and to ensure the highest possible standards of customer service.

This policy has been designed to maintain public safety and the wellbeing of our team.

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Procedure

We will do this by:

- Following and exceeding Public Health Orders.
- Implementing and enacting a current, relevant and compliant COVID Safe Plan.
- Conditions of entry will be placed on entry points, as well as be available on the Club Taree website.
- Conditions may also be noted on social media accounts or sent via members email newsletters.
- These exclusions will form the basis of our Covid Safe Entry Conditions. They will partner with a range of additional processes systems and requirements which further enhance the protection and safety of our team's, members' and guests physical and psychological health.
- Persons will also be not granted entry if they do not comply with additional conditions of entry.
- Additional conditions of entry during the Covid19 pandemic may include, however are not limited to,
 - Using the QR code sign in system
 - Wearing of a mask
 - Maintaining social distance
 - Feeling fit and well
 - Showing no signs of flu like symptoms
- In the interest of fairness and compliance there can be no exemptions to these guidelines.
- The final decision for permission of entry will be given in whole to the Chief Executive Officer.
- In his/ her absence a decision must only be made in line with this policy.

Requirements

Effective from Monday 11th October under the Public Health Orders;

- To gain entry to Club Taree and/or our Golf Course you will be required to have received a double dose of COVID19 vaccination, or have a valid exemption.
- To gain entry to Club Taree and/or our Golf Course you will be asked, and required to prove your COVID19 vaccination status to our team.
- Valid forms of proof are;
 - COVID19 Digital Vaccination Certificate
 - Immunisation History Statement
 - Apple Wallet or Google Pay Certificate
 - Contraindiction Certificate

If you cannot prove your vaccination status you will be denied entry to Club Taree and/or our Golf Course.

This policy is written in line with the requirements listed under the Public Health Orders and is not a reflection of the Board, Management and Staff. It is a requirement of law.

Club Taree may from time to time or as necessary introduce permission of entry exclusions based on postcodes, which will apply to residents of those postcodes or persons who have visited those postcodes.

Club Taree may deny entry to persons who have visited or are known to have visited venues, regions or areas of concern highlighted by the relevant health authorities.

Additional requirements under the Public Health Orders also form part of this policy.
